

SOUTH WEST FLYERS FIELD RULES 2022

- THE MAAC SAFETY CODE IS THE STANDARD THAT ALL PILOTS USING THE SOUTH WEST FLYERS FIELD SHOULD FOLLOW.
- ALL PILOTS SHOULD DISPLAY ON THEIR PERSON OR FIELD BOX A CURRENT MAAC MEMBERSHIP CARD AND BE EITHER A MEMBER OR INVITED GUEST OF THE SOUTH WEST FLYERS BEFORE CARRYING OUT ANY FLYING ACTIVITIES FROM THE CLUB FIELD.
- NO PILOT MAY FLY OR OPERATE AN RC ENGINE WHILE UNDER THE INFLUENCE OF ALCOHOL OR DRUGS.
- ONLY QUALIFIED PILOTS MAY FLY WITHOUT SUPERVISION. MEMBERS SHOULD NOT FLY ALONE.
- ONLY 2.4 MHZ RADIOS ARE ALLOWED FOR USE AT THE FIELD. ALL 72 MHZ RADIOS ARE BANNED.
- THE PIT AREA IS OPEN ONLY TO PILOTS AND THEIR ASSISTANT UNLESS GUESTS ARE INVITED IN BY A MEMBER AND ARE THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THAT MEMBER.
- WHEN STARTING ENGINES DO NOT DIRECT EXHAUST OR PROP BLAST AT OTHER FLYERS OR SPECTATORS.
- RUNNING UP OR ADJUSTMENT OF ENGINES IS NOT ALLOWED IN PIT AREA. USE RUN UP AREA BY RUNWAY.
- TAXIING IN PIT AREA IS PROHIBITED.
- PILOTS SHALL ALWAYS STAND AT A PILOT STATION AND FLY WITH THEIR BACK TO THE PIT AREA. A MAXIMUM OF FIVE PILOTS MAY FLY AT ANYONE TIME.
- AFTER TAKE OFF PILOTS MUST DIRECT THEIR AIRCRAFT AWAY FROM PARKING, SPECTATOR, AND PIT AREA AND NOT FLY BEHIND THE DESIGNATED FLIGHT LINE.
- PILOTS SHOULD LOUDLY ANNOUNCE THEIR INTENTION TO LAND AND CALL 'CLEAR' ONCE THEIR AIRCRAFT ARE AWAY FROM THE RUNWAY. DEAD STICK AIRCRAFT HAVE LANDING RIGHT OF WAY.

- WHEN TWO OR MORE PILOTS ARE FLYING A CIRCUIT, DIRECTION SHALL BE AGREED TO. THIS IS ESPECIALLY IMPORTANT IF A NOVICE OR STUDENT PILOT IS PRACTICING. PILOTS WILL ENDEAVOUR TO CROSS THE FIELD IN THE DIRECTION OF THE CIRCUIT.
- EACH PILOT IS RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY INJURY THEY MAY CAUSE TO PEOPLE OR PROPERTY WHILE THEY ARE ON SITE. THEY ARE ALSO RESPONSIBLE FOR GUESTS THAT THEY HAVE AT THE FIELD. ALL VEHICLES MUST USE THE DESIGNATED PARKING AREA.
- SPECTATORS ARE ASKED TO USE THE SPECTATOR AREA AND TO STAY BEHIND THE FLIGHT LINE. SPECTATORS ARE ONLY ALLOWED IN THE PIT AREA WITH A CLUB MEMBER. NO SPECTATORS ARE ALLOWED ON THE FLYING AREA OF THE FIELD.
- SMALL CHILDREN MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY AN ADULT AND NO UNCONTROLLED PETS ARE ALLOWED ON THE SITE.
